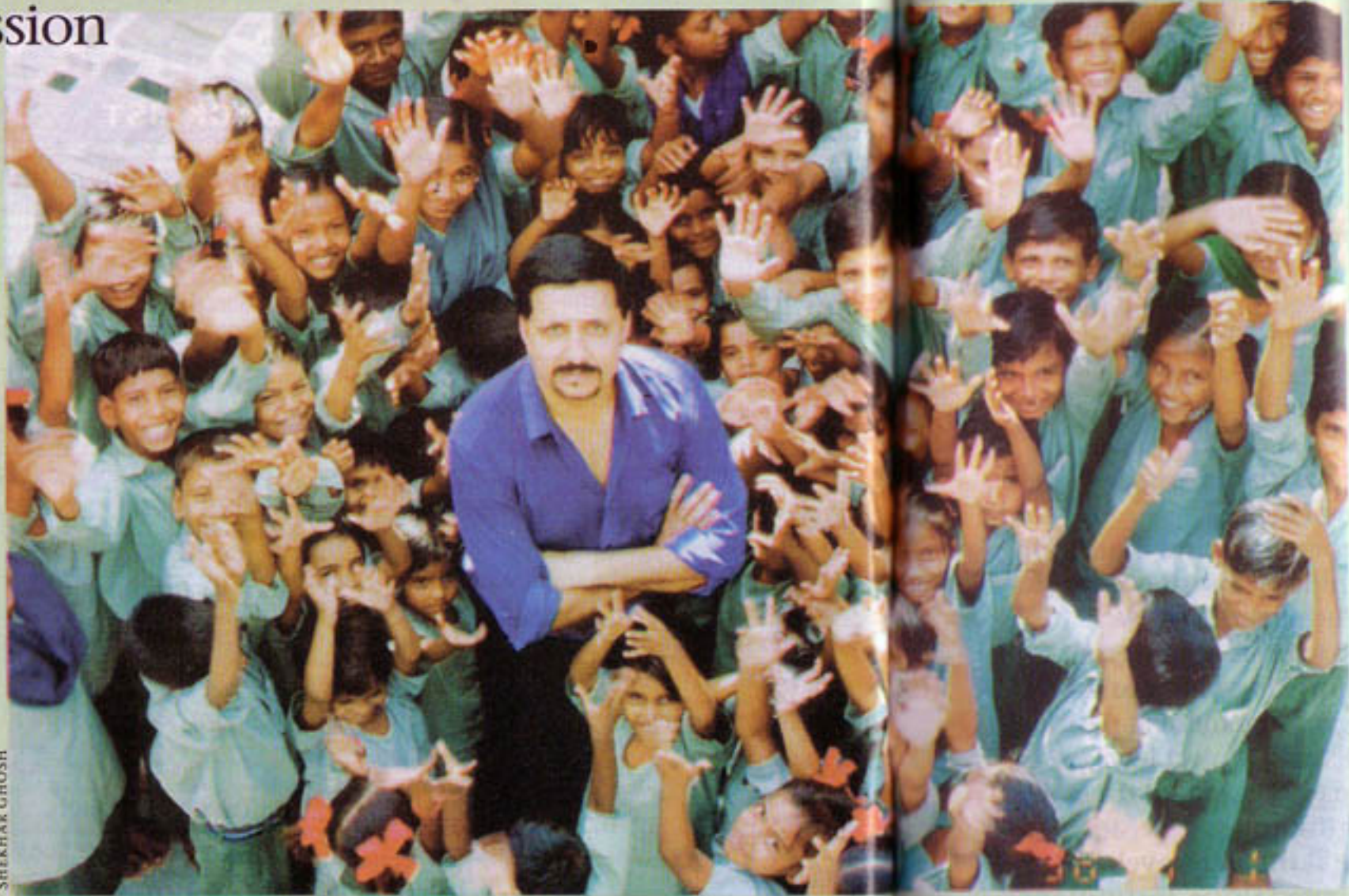


Man with a mission

Robin Raina, the 40-year-old CEO of Ebix, has been recently named amongst the 100 most powerful people in insurance in North America by *Worksite* magazine.
